SPEAKER



Brad Holmes '02 was named executive vice president and general manager of the Detroit Lions National Football League team Jan. 14, 2021. In his role, he oversees the Lions' football operations and reports directly to principal owner and chair Sheila Ford Hamp and president and CEO Rod Wood.

Holmes joined the Lions after spending 18 season with the Los Angeles Rams (2003-20). In 2013, the Rams elevated him to director of college scouting, overseeing the team's college scouting operations for eight seasons.

Holmes' vision for leading the Lions has been founded on a collaborative approach with head coach Dan Campbell as the two began reshaping the roster in 2021. Placing an emphasis on players with grit, passion and football

character. Holmes has enhanced the Lions' roster through precision in every phase of the talent acquisition process as he enters his fourth season as executive vice president and general manager.

Holmes' combination of draft success and strategic free agent signings built a roster that achieved historic success in 2023. The team finished the season with a 12-5 record, tying the franchise record for the most wins in a single season. The team also clinched a division title for the first time in 30 years and appeared in their second-ever NFC Championship Game, their first since the 1991 season. He was named Pro Football Writers of America (PFWA) Executive of the Year for his work in 2023, becoming the first Detroit Lion to win the award. During the 2024 offseason, he continued to bolster the team's roster by re-signing core players such as quarterback Jared Goff, offensive tackle Penei Sewell and wide receiver Amon-Ra St. Brown to long-term contract extensions.

The 2023 rookie class was at the forefront of the Lions' success with the group setting a single-season franchise record for the most touchdowns (22) by rookies. Tight end Sam LaPorta and running back Jahmyr Gibbs became the first set of rookie teammates to produce at least 10 touchdowns in a season. Both LaPorta and Gibbs were selected to the Pro Bowl and named to the PFWA All-Rookie team. LaPorta was also named

Associated Press (AP) Second-Team All-Pro after setting an NFL rookie tight end record with 86 receptions and leading all NFL tight ends with 10 touchdown receptions. Gibbs became the third Lions rookie to record 1,000 scrimmage yards and 10 touchdowns in a season, joining Barry Sanders (1989) and Billy Sims (1980). Linebacker Jack Campbell was the only rookie to record 80 tackles, five tackles for loss and 2.0 sacks in 2023 en route to being named to the PFWA All-Rookie Team. Defensive back Brian Branch ranked second among all rookies with three interceptions in 2023 and became the third Lions rookie to produce a pick-six in his NFL debut in franchise history.

Holmes' free agent pickups became integral parts of the 2023 Lions. Running back David Montgomery became the second Lions free agent signing to rush for 1,000 yards in his first season with the team. He also rushed for 13 touchdowns in 2023, the most a free agent signing has had in his first season with Detroit, and tied for the fourth-most any Lions player has rushed for in a single season. He and Gibbs became the first duo in NFL history to each produce 1,000 scrimmage yards and 10 touchdowns in a season. Holmes also brought back familiar faces inoffensive lineman Graham Glasgow and linebacker Jalen Reeves-Maybin. Glasgow started 15 games in 2023, including starts at all three interior offensive line positions. Voted as a team captain, Reeves-Maybin was a staple on

special teams, earning a spot in the Pro Bowl and being named AP Second-Team All-Pro.

In 2022, Holmes re-signed key players such as LB Alex Anzalone and WR Kalif Raymond after each produced career-best seasons within their first year in Detroit. Holmes' 2022 draft class echoed his approach of investing in reliable, gritty players with the selection of defensive end Aidan Hutchinson (first round, second overall) and wide receiver Jameson Williams (first round, 12th overall). Hutchinson finished second in the AP Rookie of the Year vote and concluded the season with 9.5 sacks (most among rookies), three interceptions and two fumble recoveries. His three interceptions tied for the most ever by a Lions defensive lineman in a single season.

Holmes' 2022 draft class was also highlighted by safety Kerby Joseph, linebacker Malcolm Rodriguez and linebacker James Houston. The Lions' 2022 rookie class set an NFL record for most sacks by rookie players in a single season (20.5) and ranked atop several league categories for 2022, including second in rookie interceptions (seven) and first in rookie tackles for loss (26). Joseph became the only player to ever intercept quarterback Aaron Rodgers three times in a regular season career, while Houston finished second on the team in sacks with 8.0.

The first month of Holmes' tenure in 2021 led to a blockbuster trade with the Los Angeles Rams that resulted in the Lions acquiring Goff, a 2021 thirdround pick and two future first-round draft picks in exchange for quarterback Matthew Stafford. His first offseason was capped off with one of the NFL's brightest and most productive draft classes, highlighted by the seventh

overall pick Sewell out of the University of Oregon. Sewell started 16 games as a rookie, splitting time between left and right tackle, and became the youngest player in NFL history to start a game at left tackle. St. Brown (fourth round, 112th overall), set the Lions' all-time rookie record for receptions (90) and receiving yards (912), while defensive lineman Alim McNeill (third round, 72nd overall) emerged as a foundational piece along the defensive line. That year, Holmes also inked two-time Pro Bowl center Frank Ragnow to a long-term contract extension.

Prior to the Lions, Holmes led the college scouting department for the Rams and helped the organization capture two NFC West titles en route to three playoff berths and an appearance in Super Bowl LIII. After joining the Rams in 2003 as a public relations intern, Holmes transitioned into scouting and spent nearly two decades in a variety of roles within the organization's player personnel department, including National Football Scouting scout, area scout, national combine scout and scouting assistant.

In his previous role, Holmes collaborated with the Rams' personnel directors to improve technological resources and enhance overall scouting procedures. While holding a prominent leadership role in the player personnel department from 2013-20, Holmes helped the Rams achieve a 64-58 record (.524), while having a total of 25 players named to the Pro Bowl during that span. He played an integral role in drafting several key players on the Rams' roster, including retired defensive tackle Aaron Donald, Goff, wide receiver Cooper Kupp and safety John Johnson. Holmes was also instrumental in helping the Rams acquire All-Pro cornerback Jalen Ramsey via trade in 2019.

Holmes, a Tampa, Florida native, graduated cum laude from North Carolina Agricultural and Technical State University with a B.S. in journalism and mass communication. A defensive tackle, he was a four-year letterman, two-year starter and 2001 for the Aggie football team, which won the Mid-Eastern Athletic Conference and Historically Black College and University National Championship under legendary coach Bill Hayes.

In 2022, the Chamberlain (Florida) High School Legacy Alliance recognized Holmes as a distinguished alumnus by naming the new football stadium press box in his honor.

Holmes is the son of Melvin Holmes '67, a Pittsburgh Steelers offensive lineman (1971-73), and nephew of former Lions defensive back Luther Bradley (1978 firstround pick). He and his wife Lisa have two children: son, B.J., and daughter, Lola.

HISTORY

NORTH CAROLINA AGRICULTURAL AND TECHNICAL STATE UNIVERSITY

Established in 1891, under the Second Morrill Act of 1890, North Carolina Agricultural and Technical State University is a land-grant, doctoral, high research activity university. The Second Morrill Act expanded the nation's system of land-grant universities to include a historically Black institution in those states where segregation denied minorities access to the land-grant institutions established by the First Morrill Act (1862).

Throughout its 134-year history, North Carolina A&T has maintained a rich tradition in academics, research and outreach. Today, the university is committed to fulfilling its fundamental purposes through exemplary undergraduate and graduate instruction, scholarly and creative research and effective public service and engagement. A&T is accredited by the Southern Association of Colleges and Schools Commission on Colleges. An institution of choice for high-achieving students, A&T is a preeminent land-grant university now rapidly evolving as an exponential institution.

With an enrollment of 14.311 students. A&T is the nation's largest historically Black college or university (HBCU) for the 11th consecutive year. A&T awards baccalaureate, master's and doctoral degrees through the College of Agriculture and Environmental Sciences; the College of Arts, Humanities and Social Sciences; the Willie A. Deese College of Business and Economics; the College of Education; the College of Engineering; the John R. and Kathy R. Hairston College of Health and Human Sciences; the College of Science and Technology; The Graduate College; and the Joint School of Nanoscience and Nanoengineering. The university is widely recognized for strengths in science, technology, engineering and mathematics, as well as the liberal arts and humanities and a growing array of professional programs. The university also has moved rapidly to blend its academic and research programs with the needs of

society and industry, forming a symbiotic relationship. A&T has advanced to the forefront in the area of research and is one of the top-ranking institutions in the University of North Carolina System for sponsored research funding, having secured \$250 million in contracts and grants over the past two fiscal years. The strength and potential of the research enterprise at A&T is demonstrated by the university's ability to sustain major programs in nanotechnology, biotechnology, computational science and engineering, energy and environment, information sciences and technology, leadership and community development, logistics and transportation systems, education and public health.

Upon graduating, students join the university's 70,000 alumni of record who hold (or have held) positions of leadership in industries and communities around the world. Some of A&T's nationally acclaimed alumni include Henry E. Frye '53, former N.C. Supreme Court Chief Justice; U.S. Representatives Alma S. Adams and Jonathan Jackson: Clara Adams-Ender '61, author and retired Army brigadier general; the late Alvin A. "Al" Attles Jr. '60, former NBA player, coach and general manager; Elvin Bethea '68, NFL Hall of Famer; Ezell Blair Jr./Jibreel Khazan '63, Joseph A. McNeil '63, the late Franklin E. McCain Sr. '63 and the late David Richmond '10 (degree awarded posthumously), members of the A&T Four Four; Joe L. Dudley Sr. '62, Dudley Products founder; Rev. Jesse L. Jackson Sr. '63, civil rights activist and former presidential candidate: the late Dr. Ronald E. McNair '71, NASA astronaut; and Michael S. Regan '98, former U.S. EPA Administrator.

Thirteen presidents/chancellors have served the institution since its founding: Dr. John O. Crosby 1892–1896), Dr. James B. Dudley (1896–1925), Dr. Ferdinand D.Bluford (1925–1955), Dr. Warmoth T. Gibbs (1956–1960), Dr. Samuel DeWitt Proctor (1960–1964), Dr. Lewis C. Dowdy (1964–1980), Dr. Cleon Thompson Jr. (interim, 1980–1981), Dr. Edward B. Fort (1981–1999), Dr. James C. Renick (1999–2006), Dr. Lloyd V. Hackley (interim, 2006–2007), Dr. Stanley Battle (2007–2009), Dr. Harold L. Martin Sr. (2009–2024) and Dr. James R. Martin II (current).

COSTUME

THE ACADEMIC COSTUME

The academic costume worn today derived from practices originating in the Middle Ages. When European universities were taking form in the 12th and 13th centuries, the scholars were usually clerics as well, and consequently they adopted costumes similar to those of their monastic orders. Cold halls and drafty buildings made caps and floor length gowns with attached hoods a necessity for warmth. Probably because of the costumes' religious heritage, they remained largely drab until the universities gradually began to pass from the control of the church, whereupon some aspects of the costumes took on brighter hues. Old prints reveal a strong similarity between the regalia worn in early universities and the academic costume worn today.

In light of the nation's strong English heritage, academic costume has been in use in the United States since colonial times. To establish a standard of uniformity with regard to the practice, an intercollegiate commission was formed, which prepared a code for caps, gowns and hoods that has been adopted by all universities. Originally round, the shape of the cap is now the more familiar mortarboard square - a shape that resembles a scholar's book. Legend has it that the privilege of wearing a cap was the initial right of a freed Roman slave. The flowing gown has become symbolic of the democracy of scholarship for it covers any dress, which might indicate rank or social strata. The hood not only indicates the type of degree, but also is lined with the official colors of the university from which the degree was obtained.

THE GOWN

BACHELOR - Blue, full cut with long pointed sleeves.

MASTER - Black, long or short sleeves with arc-shaped panel extended for each sleeve.

DOCTOR - Black, with velvet panels on front of gown and three velvet bars on each sleeve. Color of the velvet may be black or distinctive of the field of study.

THE HOOD

BACHELOR - Three feet in length with a two-inch wide velvet.

MASTER - Three and one-half feet in length with a three-inch wide velvet.

DOCTOR - Four feet in length with a five-inch wide velvet and panel at the sides. The lining of the hoods, which is folded out, bears the official colors of the institution from which the degree was received. The color of the velvet is Ph.D. blue.

Candidates for doctoral degrees at North Carolina Agricultural and Technical State University wear gowns fastened at the neck, hoods draped down the back and black mortarboards with a gold tassel.

UNDERGRADUATE HONOR STUDENTS

CUM LAUDE (With Honor)

Graduates with an overall grade point average of 3.25-3.49. These graduates are wearing honor cords of gold.

MAGNA CUM LAUDE (With High Honor)

Graduates with an overall grade point average of 3.50-3.74. These graduates are wearing honor cords of blue.

SUMMA CUM LAUDE (With Highest Honor)

Graduates with an overall grade point average of 3.75-4.00. These graduates are wearing honor stoles.

UNITED STATES ARMED FORCES VETERANS

These graduates are wearing white stoles.

MACE

The mace, a ceremonial insignia, dates back to ancient Rome to honor heroes and nobility. Maces were later used in the courts of England, during the reign of James I of England as symbols of authority. Today, maces are associated with academic and governmental processions. In academic use, it is the symbol of the college/university as a body of scholars within its own legally constituted authority. The chief faculty marshal carries the mace during all formal academic processions.

A gift from the graduating class of 1961, the mace of North Carolina Agricultural and Technical State University was presented October 24, 1991, during the centennial year celebration. The university's 42-inch long mace reveals a two-faced sterling silver crowning head or boss with the seals of North Carolina A&T and the University of North Carolina on either side. Both university seals rest on a sterling silver etched State of North Carolina seal.

Alternating ebony and ivory solid wood rings that symbolize the university's African American heritage are located on the mahogany wood shaft. The history and mission of the college/university throughout its 100 plus years of existence are etched on the wooden shaft of the mace between the rings. They represent service to African Americans; the missions of the university's schools and colleges; scholars; the Greensboro Four sit-in; the Aggie mascot; and sports. The base or terminus (end piece) is a silver-plated cup engraved with a figure of a runner, which symbolizes the athletic legacy and forward moving strides of the university.

A&T's mace is a result of planning, research and fund raising by the class of 1961. The special designs of the mace represent the joint efforts of the Mace Committee who contacted Emblem & Badge Inc., in Providence, Rhode Island, to craft the mace. Dr. Vallie Guthrie, chair; Dr. Dorothy Alston; Dr. Sullivan Welborne; Dr. William C. Parker; Dr. Basil Coley; Dorothy J. Richmond; Lewis Brandon III; Earnest Sherrod, and members of the class of 1961; and the Class Coordinating Committee were instrumental in the procurement and final version of the mace, which was presented during the October 24, 1991, Founder's Day Convocation. The mace was carried by the Chief Faculty Marshal (chair or president of the Faculty Senate) at the May 5, 1991, commencement and is utilized at all formal ceremonial occasions for the university.
